



**Lucky 13 Briefing**

The object of Lucky 13 is to collect as many points as possible while correctly performing a total of exactly 13 obstacles, then get on the table to stop the clock. Each obstacle is worth the points as marked. Some obstacles have a number on either side, those obstacles have a different point value based on the direction taken. Lastly, a few obstacles are bi-directional (number is beside the obstacle - the same number of points will be awarded for either direction taken, but in this case the obstacle can only be taken once for points).

Course time is 50 seconds for big dogs, 55 seconds for small dogs.

If the dog faults an obstacle, it does not count towards the 13 obstacle count, but may be performed again for points. Repeated obstacles with the same point value are not faulted but do not count for points or as one of the 13 obstacles.

If the dog performs more or less than 13 obstacles, 10 points will be taken off the score for each obstacle more or less than 13.
